GIS Business Project Manager for the GEOMSF Project

Context

Since 2013, MSF OCG has been providing Geographic Information System (GIS) services for their own operations and gradually for the whole Movement. GIS support has shown to improve programming in many areas: Emergency mapping, Epidemiological surveillance, Natural disaster preparedness and response, Program planning, Logistics, and others.

To build on these successes, to accomplish the full potential of a GIS enabled environment and in order to increase the benefits of GIS for operations, existing services need to scale up. This requires a dedicated project – the GEOMSF project, which aims to leverage crosscutting geographic information to help operations and sectors gain an understanding of a situation and its spatial context.

Led by OCG, the project will draw on three years of experience of fulfilling requests for geographic data analysis, visualizations and maps to build a platform that will significantly upgrade staff members' capacity in the field and at headquarters to easily analyze and view geo-referenced data from a) different contexts, b) sectors and c) points in time.

In order to manage the GEOMSF project complexity and international context, the project will have a dedicated Program Manager and a Team that will be structured around two streams:

- **GIS Business stream**: to manage user relationship for successful definition of user needs and GIS services, develop e-learning, administer Core GEO database and bring complementary GIS skills to IT. This stream will be managed by a GIS Business Project Manager.
- **GIS Solutions stream**: to define and implement different architectural aspects of the project (data, platform, and infrastructure) and to build the solutions that will support GIS services (Geoportal, GeoApps, and others) based on the clients' inputs. This stream will be managed by a GIS IT Project Manager.

Both project managers will report to the Program Manage according to the matrix of roles & responsibilities within the program.

Your Responsibilities

The GIS Business Project Manager for GEOMSF will manage and lead the GIS business workstream and be responsible for establishing the technical and non-functional requirements of the solution. He/She will ensure that the solutions are promoted effectively to the operations and rolled out in the most effective manner. The manager, under the oversight of the Program Manager, will also ensure the project is following the expected timeline, within budget, adhere to high quality standards and meet the internal customer expectations.

- Have a full understanding of the business requirements, project stakes, benefits, constraints, interdependencies of the GEOMSF project.
- Manage and lead the GIS Business workstream for the GEOMSF project: (business analysis, communication, data management, e-learning, field support, etc.) through the entire cycle.
- Lead or participate in the analysis, the selection, the design and implementation of the GEOMSF project solutions.
- Define and maintain detailed overall plan for the project, manage tasks and teamwork assignments, direct and monitor work efforts on a daily basis, identify resource needs, performing quality review.
- Track key project milestones and adjust project plans and/or resources to meet the needs of customers.

- Escalate functional, quality, timeline issues appropriately. Propose change requests as needed.
- Ensure coherence and good cooperation within the project team.
- Coordinate communication with all areas and stakeholders of the organization impacted by the project. Manage expectations.
- Liaise with the GIS IT Project Manager and technical team members of the GEOMSF project for the implementation and the commissioning of solutions.
- Identify one or two mature GIS related projects that could benefit from R&D.
- Report to and align with the project steering committee and Program Manager.
- Deliver project documentation and formal reporting.
- Responsible (with support of communications specialist) for development of detailed communication plan and products of communication materials, organize communication campaigns, events on GEOMSF services, tools, status and coordinate communication with all areas and stakeholders of the organization impacted by the project.
- Assist Program Manager in recruitment of staff and consultants.
- Ensure full compliance with the PMO methodology, tools and standards. Actively propose improvements
